Purpose: The mission of the SDGA Junior Tour is to provide quality and affordable competitive opportunities for junior golfers age 18 and under in South Dakota and our region. The courses will be played from appropriate lengths for each age division. All Youth golfers are encouraged to join the Junior Tour, but players are expected to be able to navigate around the course with minimal supervision and within our pace of play guidelines. They are also to exhibit proper behavior at the host club and on the course.

Format: The SDGA Junior Tour has **five** divisions: 9 & Under (9 holes), 10-11 (9 holes), 12-13, 14-15, and 16-18 (18 holes).

Eligibility: Membership is open to any junior golfer age 6-18, and all 2025 high school graduates. Age group determined by age on June 1, 2025. Members can elect to play in an older age group when registering for each event.

Fees: Membership is \$69. Entry Fee: \$20 per event. Late registration within 7 days: \$30.

Events: Members are eligible to compete in any of the 26 one-day events in three sections: West, Northeast, and Southeast.

Awards: At each event, the top three places in each age group and gender division receive medals.

Season Points and Gift Cards: Points are awarded for top 5 finishes at each event. At the end of the season all players with points will receive a gift card worth the number of points they have earned. In each region, the top point leaders in each age group and gender division receive a plaque.

Point Leaders - SDGA Junior Tour Cup: Top finishers in each event earn points and point leaders in each section will be recognized. The top two boy and girl point leaders in each age division (except 9 & under) will be invited to compete in the SDGA Junior Tour Cup on Monday, August 4 at Hillsview GC in Pierre.

Sanford International: Winners of each age division and gender at the Junior Tour Cup will receive an invitation to the final round of The Sanford International on Sunday, September 14. They will have lunch with dignitaries, and have the opportunity to meet and get a picture with the Champion at the end of the tournament.
